

3070 CONFINED SPACE ENTRY

Objective

To gain an understanding of the safe methods and procedures to enter a confined space safely.

Prerequisite

Working knowledge of SCBA

Target Group

Any person who would be required to enter a confined space.

Methodology

Classroom instruction and practical.

Content

- Definition and understanding of confined space.
- Definition and understanding of hazards associated with confined space.
- Demonstration of the use of SCBA, personal protective clothing, scene safety equipment, use of air quality monitors, use of communication equipment, and ventilation equipment.

Certification

A certificate of attainment will be issued upon successful completion of the course.

Enrolment

Minimum 10 students

Maximum 16 students

Duration

Two days

Location

Nova Scotia Firefighters School or suitable location.

Student should bring turnout gear and suitable work clothes. (There is a limited supply of gear at the School)
