

3072 CONFINED SPACE RESCUE

Objective

To provide an understanding of various fundamentals as they relate to Confined Space Rescue Operations and to provide a controlled setting in which to develop certain skills, used to provide rescue and scene safety.

Prerequisites

- Working knowledge of SCBA
- Confined Space Entry – course 3070

Target Group

Any person who would be responsible to perform rescue in a confined space.

Methodology

Classroom instruction and practical.

Content.

- Demonstrate the use of SCBA, personal protective clothing, scene safety equipment, air quality equipment, communication equipment, and ventilation equipment.
- Demonstrate the use of a rescue tripod.
- Demonstrate the use of a mechanical fall protection device.
- Demonstrate the use of a running fall protection system.
- Demonstrate patient retrieval methods.
- Demonstrate tool and equipment retrieval methods.
- Explain the need for decontamination in Hazardous Material responses.

Certification

A certificate of attainment will be issued upon successful completion of the course.

Minimum 10 students
Maximum 16 students

Duration

Two days (one weekend)

Nova Scotia Firefighters School.
