

3082 INTERMEDIATE RAPID INTERVENTION

Objective

To develop the skills, and training needed by firefighters to effectively monitor fire situations and have in place the necessary tools and equipment to rescue any downed firefighters or any firefighters in trouble at structure fires as mandated by NFPA 1500.

- 3081 Rapid Intervention Training

- Experienced Company Officers (review)

Methodology

Classroom instruction and practical evolutions.

Content

- On Scene Organization and Preparation
- Exterior Rescue Evolutions
- Deployment the Two Team Rapid Intervention (RIT) Concept
- Maximizing the use of RIT
- Accountability

Certification

A certificate of attendance shall be issued upon successful completion of the course.

Duration

2 days (one weekend)
