

# 3083      **ADVANCED RAPID INTERVENTION TECHNIQUES**

## **Objective**

To develop the skills needed by firefighters to effectively monitor fire situations and have in place the necessary tools and equipment to rescue any downed firefighters or any firefighters in trouble at structure fires as mandated by NFPA 1500.

## **Prerequisites**

- Firefighter Level I
- 3081 Rapid Intervention training
- 3082 Intermediate Rapid Intervention

## **Target Group**

- Firefighter I and II
- Newly appointed Company Officers.
- Experienced Company Officers (review).

## **Methodology**

Practical scenario evolutions.

## **Content**

Practical skills based on Rapid Intervention Training, and Intermediate Rapid Intervention, in the form of scenarios that will be done on a 24 hour period day and night starting 8:00 Saturday morning and ending 8:00 Sunday morning

## **Certification**

A certificate of attendance shall be issued upon successful completion of the course.

## **Enrollment**

Minimum 10 students

Maximum 12 students

## **Duration**

24 hrs starting 8 Sat morning and ending 8 Sun morn
