Methodology

Content

Students completing this program will have a working knowledge of how to complete a vehicle fire investigation. The program begins in the class room with the latest training in accordance with NFPA 921 (2008 edition) and ends with the practical application of this knowledge with real fires in real vehicles.

Certification

Certificate of attainment will be issued upon successful completion of the course

Minimum 15 students

Duration

2 days (1 weekend)

Location

Nova Scotia Firefighters School or any suitable location.
