- Fire safety inspection and public fire education – responsibilities of the Fire Officer
- Specialized fire protection equipment and water systems overview
- Organizational communications

Certification for this course is through the Nova Scotia Professional Qualifications Board and all applications must be submitted to the Nova Scotia Firefighters School a month in advance of the course for the tests to be processed.
